Approval of invoices:

Resolutions:

Resolution 25-007: Approving Amendment 1 to Difference Makers, LLC Contract – District Administrator Ryan Barret spoke to the resolution. This resolution allows for additional funds be added to Eric Eisenberg's contract and for the District Administrator to sign. Supervisor Pollock made a motion to approve Resolution 25-007. Supervisor Swope seconded. **Motion passed 3-0.**

OCB Update:

Edna Fund spoke to the group about the possibility of a combined effort with ASRP, Flood Authority, Flood Control and the OCB as a multi-front for flood mitigation.

J Vander Stoep mentioned the presentation with Tyson Johnston, and he was impressed that all parties were so aligned in engaging a firm to conduct the comparative and cost benefit analyses and seek support from the OCB to decide upon a comprehensive fish and flood strategy.

District Update:

Ryan Barrett informed the Supervisors there have been two responses for the current vacant position.

Scott Brummer said there has been a request from Ecology Director Casey Sixkiller to meet with the District. Meeting with his staff to iron out details of a May 13th 12PM-1:30PM catered lunch, agenda to-bedetermined. The goal for the lunch is to have some good conversations with the Department of Ecology.
