Project update

Matt Dillin provided project updates. Matt said the Revised Project Description was presented to the state and federal agencies during an in-person interagency meeting. Matt said the Revised Mitigation Plan is due mid-July. District learned that the SEPA officials have decided to publish a Revised Draft EIS. The SEPA Final EIS is expected in roughly two years. Eric Eisenberg stated that the NEPA is a longer process. This is due to permitting. Eric said big projects with big impacts take a long time and he said the NEPA and SEPA schedules will come together.

Office of the Chehalis Basin update

Edna said at the last OCB meeting, budget for the 2025-2027 year is being proposed. Edna also informed the group about a letter the Quinault Tribe has sent to the Washington Department of Fish & Wildlife (WDFW). The Quinault Tribe is stating they want the dam to be removed from the Skookumchuck River. Edna said the work to be done is between WDFW and the Quinault Tribe. Eric said an environmental study will need to be performed to assess all impacts associated with the dam removal.

Dan Maughn said the Land Committee reached out to him. Dan said they are proposing a draft to build a dike around Adna.

Frank Corbin proposed to amend the May 9th minutes to state Dan Maughn seconded the minute motion Dave Mueller seconded. **Motion passed 8-0.**
